December 18, 2012 RSO meeting.

Nine members present: Jim Bradbury, Tom Ekberg, Phil Erickson, Tom Fix, Larry Gardner, Tom Hunt, Mike McCarthy, Clinton Shaw, and Henry Sherwood.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Phil Erickson, who was acting for John Mulhall. After the Pledge of Allegiance, it was announced that a members-present sign-in sheet was being passed around, as well as a January 2013 RSO duty sign-up sheet to be given to Bud Cross.

New business: John Mulhall had requested that the meeting begin with a discussion of .223 rifle usage on the pistol range, and this discussion ensued. RSO's have been repeatedly finding .223 rifle brass on the pistol range, much of it scattered around the 10-yard area. Hank Sherwood has taken pictures of some of them. It appears irrefutable from this that people are shooting AR-15 rifle(s) on the pistol range. This is absolutely forbidden. These bullets are damaging the steel backstop, which both damages club property and creates a hazard for pistol shooters. We will first need to stop this activity, then make extensive necessary repairs to the steel backstop.

The discussion centered around how this could be happening. When one RSO asked if the police might be doing it during rental of the range, Larry Gardner said no, LEO's are absolutely not doing this. Accepting this means that it is done by RSO's, general members, non-members, or by off-duty LEO's. It may be caused by non-members walking onto the property when the range is closed, but that would entail risk and yield no reward, and so it is highly unlikely anyone would bother to do this. It may be general members or RSO's or LEO's with a gate key entering the range when the range is closed. Finally, it may be happening during open hours, by members or non-members, when RSO's are on duty.

It was decided to attempt to get more information on who & when. John Mulhall is already getting gate records for periods when the rifle brass has been found. Tom Hunt and Phil Erickson agreed to rewrite the RSO sign-in sheet to add a final check-in item, a walk-through of the pistol range to look for rifle brass and a notation on the RSO log of any found. This was done this day. Bud Cross was asked by e-mail to send an e-mail to all RSO's, advising them of this. This was done the next day.

Other new business: John Mulhall wanted RSO's to be reminded that he is arranging for a bulk order of bullets from Rainier Bullets. He so far has requests for 18,000 of the 35,000 bullets needed for this first order, which will lock us into the bulk price network. A discussion ensued about orders and prices. RSOs who wish to be a part of this order should contact John.

Phil mentioned that John asks again that RSOs must remember to enter the cash register money contents as they arrive for duty, so that no one's honor is questioned if something turns up missing.

Old business: Phil mentioned that John asked him to pursue the ongoing discussion of the 200-yard range usage, but as our time had nearly run out, this was postponed until the January meeting.

It was moved by Cork Carpenter and seconded by Bob Ballard that the November 20, 2012 General Membership meeting minutes be approved as corrected. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report:

BDGC is solvent as of December 4, 2012. Financial reports are provided at the board meeting each month.

(See attached) Cork Carpenter made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Pat Manyon, Motion Carried.

Committee Reports:

Continental League – Pat Manyon reported we had 52 shooters, 11 squads using 5,200 targets for the Continental warm up shoot on December 16th. The competition shoot is scheduled for January 20th. Jim Gillis and Marion Dukes will set traps back tomorrow with 4 & 5 being left set for Continental and 1,2 & 3 for Singles and Handicaps. Note re: Continental traps, during practice they were set to Jim Gillis' direction with a range of 10" low and 25.7 high and we received good comments that "most consistent birds from field to field". We still need traphouse loaders, scorers and relievers. The breakfast and lunch cooks are all planned with menus set. Continental league punch cards are for sale to BDGC Continental shooters enabling you to get 20 rounds for \$60.00. See Sharon at the desk to purchase.

Jim Bradbury – Jim has tried to again contact the White Flyer trucking company to coordinate hull pick up with delivery of their targets to SST. We are being held up because we do not know the size of bag they want us to collect and submit the hulls for recycling in. We will be able to build a frame to hold the collection bag once we know the size of bag. We will be able to recycle the hulls for benches and other items they build from the hulls.

Jim Forczek – The Audit committee is still working on the Audit report to have done by year end.

Bob Sadesk - No report

John Griffin – He had a live shoot Hunters Ed class for 11 people from Muckelshoot this month.

Marion Dukes – The PITA shoots are scheduled for the first weekend of June the 1st & 2nd and the third weekend of August 17th & 18th. Marion is looking for the support staff to put on the shoot and cooks for breakfast and lunch.

Pat Manyon – BDGC insurance papers are now ready for review by someone in the field that can understand the verbage to see if we are duplicating coverage. New member knows a good contact in the industry that has said he will review the policies for us.

Chief RSO Position- John Mulhall will leave the CRSO position at the end of January. He has other issues to attend to so the club is looking or someone who will attend board meetings and be visible at the range as part of the CRSO duties. A motion was made by Cork Carpenter and seconded by Tom Hunt to ask membership for nominations for those interested in fulfilling the CRSO position.

Tom Hunt-

Sportco -Federal Ammunition Report will be coming in soon, by April 2013. We need to be sure to specify the size shot you want as they will substitute. We need to know the quantity we used in 2012 to be able to order to take advantage of the pricing. We should also designate a delivery recipient to be at the club when delivery is expected so inventory can be off-loaded and stored. Bob Ballard will look into this.

Weyerhaeuser Land Acquisition- We need to stay on top of what the intent of Weyerhaeuser is to selling property as it seems there is some movement. We have heard that possible Quadrant homes may be interested in buying land.

Grant Committee Update- Merv is unable to be here tonight due to a family funeral. The Grant committee is researching applying for funding from Amateur Trapshooting Assoc. another source that will give money to gun clubs. The NRA grant has been submitted and will soon start preparation for another grant request. NSSF grant request is being worked on for a June submission.

Year End Reports- Due in January as listed in last month's General Meeting minutes.

Club Property Tax-Tom looked into the taxes on the BDGC land because he thought they were high. A consultant at RCO looked into the issue. Tom would like the club to apply for the BDGC property to be re-evaluated from residential to forest land, We need a person to work the plan and plan the work. Cork will talk with Joe Nagel.

Club Positions- Toms philosophy is that more hands helping to run the club is a good thing. He supports us asking the membership for people to become: Editor, Newsletter chairman, Web Page chairman, Membership chairman. If the Secretary and Treasurer positions are vacated because the people filling the current positions would rather take a chairmanship, those positions would require filling.

Interclub Shoot – BDGC was the winner of the Interclub shoot with SST this year. The trophy plaque will return to our clubhouse and be seen by all near the clubhouse doors.

Nominating Committee – The slate of officers running for 2013 club year are:
